



In the beginning of 2000 Agrinas received a request to enter into an official partnership with a Dutch agriculturalist who was working in Kazakhstan. It was agreed that Agrinas would extend official registration as an affiliated office, render expertise, and help in networking with sponsors for project financing.

At the end of 2013 Agrinas-Kazakhstan officially ceased to exist. The micro-credit organisation that originated from Agrinas, is continuing to support the (rural) population in it's further development.
